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Natural Resources Environmental Science and Education Subcommittee	Overall objective: Cultivate collaborations in environmental science and education between Virginia and Santa Catarina in such areas as ecosystems, water quality and quantity (AQ2) and other areas as determined by the collaborations.  Specific objectives:  1. Facilitate connections and communications between university faculty and other environmental professionals in both VA and SC for sharing and/or collaboration in research and practical applications.  2. Exchange/share already-existing programs and lessons for school children between the VA and SC chapters. Consider collaboratively producing new resources.  3. Develop a unique citizen science program involving both VA and SC, with the possibility of engaging other Partner chapters at some time.
